To recognize Domestic Violence Awareness Month a memorial display was held at the Detroit Lakes City Park during the first week of October. Life-size silhouettes lined the sidewalk, each one representing a domestic violence related homicide in Minnesota from August 2022 to August 2023. Thirty one victims were remembered during our 1st Annual Break the Silence Memorial, ranging in age from 9 days old to 77 years. This solemn, vet impactful, memorial was viewed by hundreds of people during the week as our community

took strides to "Break the Silence" regarding domestic violence. It was especially meaningful to have family members and friends of victims

This event would not have been possible without the help of some great friends. Colin Buschette cut out and assembled all the silhouettes, and students from the Detroit Lakes High School ALC class helped us paint each one. We are beyond grateful, thank you!
